Summary:

The preparatory visit was very beneficial and exceeded our expectations. When searching for a potential partner, we looked for possible contacts via the Internet and personal experience of colleagues from other schools in our region who had already worked with Norway. We got an e-mail contact of a representative of the educational center KREATIVT GJENBRUKSSENTER I SALTEN AS which we later contacted with a request for po-

tential cooperation. The possibility of personal contact and disussions when the planning activities undoubtedly project was beneficial. The planned activities, the concrete fulfillment of our ideas about the work of the selected partner (with illustrative examples of their work with the target group), professionalism of the participants and their experience with the implementation of projects brought such results that we could not achieve through emails only. Unexpected for us was also the opportunity to cooperate with the local university - NORD University in Bodø which, among other things, focuses on environmental policy. We agreed on future cooperation which we are very much looking forward to. Based on our experience from the preparatory visit, willingness, professionalism and enthusiasm of the representatives of the donor state, we would certainly recommend similar cooperation to other schools.

Summary:

At the contact seminar, I preliminarily agreed with two colleagues from Norway on possible future cooperation. During the subsequent preparatory visit to Norway, I had the opportunity to meet other colleagues who intended to be involved in the project and the places - institutions, workplaces - where the pro-

jects will take place. After meeting with colleagues in person, we partially changed the goals and content of the originally planned projects - we adapted them to the possibilities of Secondary nursing school and Tertiary vocational all the participants. I received maximum support from the partners and the cooperation resulted in two project applications (mobility project and VET project). Our school will benefit not only from the exchange of participants' experience in the field of health care, but also from their acquaintance with the cultural and social environment of the partner, including the increase in their language competencies. I would definitely recommend cooperation with partners from Norway to other Czech schools.

The idea of this project started in October 2019 when both partners met at the contact seminar for the EEA Grants in Prague.
