

The Institute for Development and Diplomacy (IDD) of ADA University is delighted to announce a Call for Applications to the 16th annual Baku Summer Energy School (BSES).

BSES is an annual two-week certificate program offered in July by ADA University in partnership with the State Oil Company of the Azerbaijan Republic (SOCAR) and bp Azerbaijan.

The 16th BSES will be held on the <u>ADA University</u> campus on July 16–30, 2022. The program's first week will be dedicated to the oil and gas industry, while the second week will be discussing green and renewable energy.

In particular, the following topics will be discussed:

- Energy fundamentals
- Energy economics
- Energy law
- Energy geopolitics
- Natural resource revenue governance
- Sustainable development and climate change
- Renewable energy
- Electricity markets and their reforms
- Global and regional energy outlook

BSES is organized for graduate students, junior and mid-career professionals working in the field of energy and the environment and/or with a particular interest in post-Soviet Eurasia and the Caspian. Please note that the program requires full proficiency in English.

Tuition fee for the 2022 Baku Summer Energy School is 2000 EURO. The fee includes teaching materials, field trip related costs, as well as all receptions, lunches and coffee breaks. The IDD grants a limited number of partial and full tuition scholarships to outstanding participants on the basis of the financial need and merit.

To apply for Baku Summer Energy School, all applicants are required to submit their applications by **May 30, 2022**.
