## Description

## Process

### Step-by-Step

- Step 1:** Application + CV (between 2 months to 6 months prior to desired start period). This includes indicating top 2-3 fields of choice
- Step 2:** Informational interview
- Step 3:** If approved, confirm placement with a deposit
- Step 4:** Placement process, interviews with companies/organizations
- Step 5:** Internship & housing (if part of package) confirmation, total fee due
- Step 6:** With UO credentials, obtain J-1 Student Intern visa

### Program Length

8 weeks to 12 weeks. Most internships are 12 weeks.

### Housing

New York: shared or private room, included in fee  
Washington, D.C. : shared or private room, included in fee

### English Fluency

English fluency is not required; however, English ability should be between conversational and advanced

All programs include visa sponsorship and personalized professional development module (tools, trainings and workshops). Depending on the program selected, the following may be included:

- Private accommodation with access to amenities
- Welcome package with maps, transportation cards
- Intercultural competence training and assessment
- 24/7 emergency assistance from local staff
- Active international intern community
- Local activities and organized trips
- Insurance recommendations

#### **Standard option (New York and Washington, D.C.)**

Includes accommodation, amenities, internship placement services, ongoing professional development, full program staff services and additional activities. Ideal for complete peace of mind and quality cultural and professional experience.
