### **Definition of microcredentials**



**Microcredential** (or mikrocertifikát in Czech) is an electronic record – a certificate – confirming completion of a small scale learning units expressed by ECTS credits and confirming the achievement of clearly defined and comprehensive learning outcomes – a set of knowledge, skills, and attitudes that constitute competencies.

**Learning units** are linked to the EQF, subject to a system of standardized quality assurance processes, and assessed according to transparent and well-defined criteria.

# 1. Analysis of Documentation for Skill-enhancing Education on a national level

### **Content of the Analysis**

 Evaluation of current state of documentation (certificates, etc.) for skill-enhancing education (upskilling or reskilling courses, lifelong learning)


 Results: 9 specific recommendations for best practices in document format and content for enhancing the quality and consistency of documentation

## 2. Analysis of Documentation for Skill-enhancing Education on EU and international level



- Extensive comparison of documentation practices and national frameworks + Survey among 21 universities from 15 different countries
- Analysis was focused on Europe and selected countries around the world (e.g. USA, Canada, New Zealand, Australia)
- Results: Recommendations for best practices and open questions

## 3. Methodology for Unifying Short-Term Education through the ECTS

- Standardised methodology
- ► Two-phase feedback involving all 26 participating universities
- ► Aim to promote transparency and comparability in short-term education
- ▶ Implications: facilitating credit transfer and recognition of microcertificates

### 4. Unified Online Catalog of Courses Leading to Microcredentials



- ▶ **Aims:** The workgroup had defined a standardized format for exporting course data from the information systems of individual public universities
- Centralizes data repository allows presenting of courses not only through the online catalog but also possible other platforms
- ▶ Implications: to enhance accessibility, visibility and informed decision-making of target interested groups (e.g. graduates, highly skilled professionals)

### 5. Proposal for Unified Certificate Format



- The workgroup developed unifed version of the certificate and its manual
- ▶ Emphasis is on detailed analysis of standardized items listed on the certificate and its electronic form ensuring its full compatibility with Unified Information System for Education Results Verification
- Importance: academic recognition and credibility

## 6. Unified Information System for Education Results Verification

- ► Aim: to introduce a unified information system facilitating education results verification process (for both academic and professional purposes)
- Based on an analysis of the technical possibilities for the information system a solution based on EDCI principle (Europass) was chosen - using a structured text file (JSON) containing all the required information about the course and microcredential holder in an unencrypted form and an electronic seal of the issuing institution.
- ▶ Importance: Implementing basic principle of designing and issuing microcredentials at the EU level portability (the ability of the holder to easily store and share microcredentials)

# 7. Methodology for Recognizing Education Verified by Microcredentials

- ▶ **Aims:** The workgroup is developing a draft version of the standardized methodology for recognizing education verified by microcredentials for academic purposes
- ▶ Two-phase feedback involving all 26 participating universities follows
- Aim to align with relevant legislation and regulations while fulfill a fundamental principle of microcertificates on the European level: academic recognition
- ▶ Implications: standardization and academic acceptance
