Teaching was modernised and institutional cooperation was enhanced.



78 joint intellectual outputs created

target: 52



1,400 participants of peer-learning activities

target: 330



Democracy and citizenship education was supported.



70 schools applied new methods of democracy and citizenship education

target: 36

12 % of projects enabled closer cooperation between schools and local communities



Skills and competences of students, staff and other education experts were improved.





563 students **311** staff participated in mobility
